Statement of Faith

Bethel Baptist Christian Academy and all of the programs which it operates are founded upon the infallible Word of God (the Bible) as interpreted in the doctrinal statement of Bethel Baptist Church of Jamestown, New York. The entire document may be secured from the church office. A brief summary is as follows:

- 1 We believe that the Scriptures, consisting of the Old and New Testaments, are verbally inspired by God, and are inerrant in the original writings, and that they are supreme and the final authority for faith and life.
- 2 We believe in one God eternally existing in three persons – Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.
- 3 We believe that Jesus Christ was begotten by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, and is true God and true Man.
- 4 We believe that man was created in the image of God, that he sinned and thereby incurred not only physical death, but also spiritual death which is separation from God; and that all human beings are born with a sinful nature.
- 5 We believe that the Lord Jesus Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures as representative and substitutionary sacrifice; thus, all who believe in Him are justified through His blood.
- 6 We believe in the resurrection of the crucified body of our Lord Jesus Christ, in His ascension to heaven, and in His present life there for us as High Priest and Advocate.
- 7 We believe in the personal, pre-millennial, and imminent return of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.
- 8 We believe that all who receive the Lord Jesus Christ by faith are born again of the Holy Spirit and thereby become children of God.
- 9 We believe in the preeminence of the local and visible church, baptism by immersion for believers, and the ordinance of the Lord's Supper.
- 10 We believe in the bodily resurrection of the just and the unjust, the everlasting blessedness of the saved, and the everlasting punishment of the lost.

We will set forth in this covenant, the expectations which our parents can expect us to do or provide in order to meet the goals of our mission statement and prove our intent to do our best for each student.

Through this covenant between Bethel Baptist Christian Academy and parents, we mutually pledge to strive to meet the expectations listed below:

- To provide a community that is Christ-centered, safe, and supportive.
- To pray for each student, by name, on a regular basis.
- To keep parents informed of their children's progress through report cards, progress reports, merit reports, standardized testing scores, and conferences.
- To work closely with families to assist with the personal and social development of each child.
- To encourage good citizenship through community service and/or church related projects and events.
- To provide opportunities to learn independently.
- To provide assistance to senior high students with choosing a career/college and with applying for financial aid.
- To refuse to allow a student to pass on to the next grade until he/she possesses the knowledge and skills necessary for success in the upcoming grade level.

Should it become apparent to the parents/guardians of the above named students or the Administrative Team of Bethel Baptist Christian Academy, the covenantal partnership between them may be dissolved after a minimum of three attempts at reconciliation and restoration have been made. Dissolution of the partnership covenant will result in disenrollment of the above named students from Bethel Baptist Christian Academy.

As a Parent/Guardian I commit to:

- ◆ Seek to nurture a desire for the love of and obedience to God in the life of my student(s).
- ◆ Work to see that my student(s) are in school every day except in case of illness with his necessary books, materials, and supplies.
- ◆ Make sure that students arrive at school with ample time to organize books and supplies and be seated in homeroom at the designated start of the school day*.
- ◆ Attend report card conferences. If I am unable to attend at a designated time, I will call the school to arrange an alternative time.
- ◆ Work with staff to promote appropriate speech, behavior, and social development in my student(s). Close cooperation and rapid response are particularly important when a student's behavior is not in accordance with the standards of BBCA.
- ◆ Discuss any concerns or perceived problems concerning my student with my student's teacher in a timely manner. If the situation cannot be remedied or resolved, I may call for an appointment to meet with the teacher and a school official so that my student's interests can be served.
- ◆ Provide my student(s) access to a quiet, distraction-free environment for homework and studying. Preferably, this area will be free of television, radio, telephone, video games, and young children.
- ◆ Schedule ample time on evenings and weekends for my student(s) to complete assigned homework.
- ◆ Pick up my student(s) at the designated dismissal time* at the end of the school day or after the end of any extra-curricular or co-curricular event unless other arrangements have been made. Fees will be charged for late departures.
- ◆ Meet all my financial obligations in a timely manner.
